Primitivo di Manduria 2021 (Produttori di Manduria)

8.50/38

-Primitivo is a characteristic wine from Puglia in south Italy. The flavour it's smooth and full. The bouquet has nuances of red fruits and plums, with a light sweet aftertaste. This wine is aged for 9 months in barrels, therefore it has light tannin flavours.

-Grapes: Primitivo

Valpolicella ripasso 2020 (Benedetti)

-Deep, bright red wine, with a lot of red fruit in the scent: especially Amarena cherry and plums. Full warm taste, excellently balanced with soft tannins and long, warm aftertaste.

Rosso Toscano 2021 (Vigliano) Natural, Biodynamic

-Pure sangiovese from the hills of Florence. Paolo has been working according to the biodynamic principles. Subtle and pure natural wine with enough strength hearty dishes

Onica Rubicone 2020 (Amaracmand) Natural, Organic

54

-This Natural wine has a deep red color. Nuances of cranberries, walnuts, tobacco, chestnuts, soft tannins and a balanced acidity. Approximately 10% of the grapes undergo ventilated whitening for about ten days before being pressed with 90% grapes.

Imperfetto Rubicone 2021 (Amaracmand) Natural, Organic

72

-Organic grapes from the finest Sangiovese varieties are selected to be withered for about fifteen days. The grapes are then pressed and left with the skin for at least ten days. The wine is then refined in French barrels as well as steel tanks. The resulting wine is then aged in bottle for at least six more months. The wine presents a deep bordeaux color, nuances of walnuts, dried Porcini-mushrooms, plums, black berries. The taste is completed by a perfectly balanced acidity and a deep aftertaste.

Campania

- Cecubo** 2015 (Villa Matilde) 70
-An historic wine already appreciated by the ancient Romans, produced with old indigenous grapes. The grapes are picked and selected by hand. The resulting stays 12 months in oak barrels. This wine from Campania has a dark, dense red color with an unmistakable scent of plums, berries, vanilla and cacao.

- Taurasi** 2016 (Villa Matilde) 85
-This wine has a deep red color. Aroma of wild berries and licorice. Tannins and delicate notes of violet are smoothly blended. This wine is then refined in barrel for 18 months and aged in bottle for 12 months.

- Rubellio Aglianico del Taburno** 2017 (La Masseria di Maria) 85
-Intense ruby red color with purple reflections. Fruity and complex aroma, the taste is excellent body, rightly tannic and persistent. The "Rubellio Aglianico del Taburno Riserva" is made from pure Aglianico grapes carefully selected during the harvest phase and subjected to three years of aging / refining in French oak barriques, six months in the bottle.

- Vigna Camarato** 2011 (Villa Matilde) 120
-Vigna Camarato is a real grand cru, located on the slopes of the extinct volcano of Roccamonfina; The wine produced from this vineyard is made only in deserving vintages. Dark and deep red in the color, intense and persistent aroma of black berries, pepper, chocolate, coffee, licorice and vanilla. Refined in oak barrels for 12/18 months (1/3 new, 1/3 second passage, 1/3 third passage) and continues to age in the bottle for another 12/18 months.

- Cerasuolo** 2020 (Avide) Biological 50
-Ruby red with garnet reflections, fruity with floral aromas and hints of pomegranate and red fruit. Fresh, moderately tannic, well balanced.
-Grapes: Frappato, Nero d'Avola
- Frappato** 2021 (Paolo Cali) Biological 54
-Ruby red. Rich, fine and elegant, Clean deep fruity with notes of small red fruit such as cherry, blackberry and mulberry with emphasized floral scent

- Cratere** 2017 (Terrazze dell'Etna) Biological 60
-Intense ruby red, violet reflections. Ripe and balsamic fruit with a scent of lava. In the mouth is sapid, dynamic with a long and constant structure. Harvesting in October. Lengthy and controlled maceration. Ageing 6 month in wood and 24 month in bottle.

Toscana

Morellino di Scansano Riserva 2014 (Boschetto di Montiano)

60

–Malolactic fermentation in steel, followed by maturation in French oak wood for approximately 18 months. It's then aged in the bottle for approximately 12 months. The bouquet has ripe red fruits notes with soft tannins in the aftertaste.

–Grapes: Sangiovese, Cabernet Franc, Merlot

Aleato Estivo 2021 (I Mandorli) Natural, Biodynamic

65

–Biodynamic sangiovese from the Tuscan coast; natural yeasts, unfiltered, minimal sulphites, pure, genuine, natural wine.

–Grapes: Aleatico, Sangiovese

Ai Confini del Bosco 2020 (Mulini di Segalari) Natural, Biodynamic

80

–This wine is aged in oak barrels for 15 month, follows 12/18 months refining in bottle. The sense of smell is dominated by fruity scent of ripe cherries, black currant, undergrowth. In the mouth slightly tannic wine with hints of fruit and spices

–Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot Petit Verdot Syrah

Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 (I Mandorli) Natural, Biodynamic

85

–100% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes it's a blend of two different vinifications of grapes from the vineyard plot facing the sea: the grapes from the older vines and the younger vines are harvested separately. They then undergo separate spontaneous alcoholic fermentation in open vats. Subsequently, they are blended together and continue aging for 8 months in barrels, another 8 months in concrete, and 12 months in the bottle.

Brunello di Montalcino 2018 (Ridolfi) Biological

100

–Brunello is one of the great wines of Italy. The power lies in elegance and refinement, not in concentration. Classical aging in large wooden barrels, characteristic light red color, fine red fruit, spices and undergrowth. Made by one of the great cellar masters of Montalcino.

–Grapes: Sangiovese

Veneto

Amarone della Valpolicella 2018 (Corte Bravi) Natural, Biological

100

–This wine comes from a selection of grapes, withered in wooden boxes for 3 month. Maceration comes with natural yeasts. The wine is then aged for 3 years in barrels and then refined in bottle.

The bouquet presents cherries in alcohol, dried plums and chocolate. Soft tannins, deep aftertaste.

–Grapes: Corvina Veronese, Corvinone, Rondinella, Molinara

Piemonte

Dogliani "San Luigi" 2021 (Pecchenino) Biological

45

-Purple-red color with violet hues. Characterized by aromas of blackberries, raspberries, blueberries and red cherries. Mineral note. Medium body, soft tannins, moderate acidity and good balance. The wine is the product of several vineyards with south-east, south and south-west exposures. The soil is calcareous-clayey. After pressing, the must ferments in steel tanks for 10-12 days at a temperature of 26°C. After an initial decanting, malolactic fermentation naturally develops.

Langhe Nebbiolo "Frerò" 2021 (Santa Maria) Biological

80

-Capalòt has been famous in Barolo for decades. The family has had a vineyard there since 1850. Walter works organically and naturally according to a long tradition. 'Frerò' or brother in dialect also comes from this Barolo vineyard, but is raised on stainless steel. Valter wants to keep the emphasis on the fruit. This, combined with the generous character of La Morra, leads to a sultry, very drinkable Nebbiolo with a good bite.

Barolo "San Giuseppe" 2018 (Pecchenino) Biological

-Pecchenino's "San Giuseppe" Barolo is a classic interpretation of the Langhe, with a typical, broad and elegant aromatic set. In the glass it shows a brilliant ruby red. The nose reveals hints of violets, berries and balsamic herbs. In the mouth it is balanced and structured, with vigorous tannins and a long persistence

-Typical for Friuli, *frasca* is the tavern section of a winery where the grower can serve his wine and salume to visitors. This blend of local varieties was made at our special request!

Ribolla Gialla Colli Orientali 2022 (Marco Sara) Natural, Organic

-Marco Sara has been part of the original natural wine movement in Italy since the beginning. Still adhering to its minimum intervention principles, his wines are mineral and clean. The scent is fruity and floral, with fresh notes of herbs. The taste is smooth and pleasant, juicy and easy-drinking.

Fiano di Avellino 2022 (Fonzone) Biodynamic

-Fonzone is one of the embodiments of the wine-growing renaissance in Campania (the region surrounding Naples). Respect for tradition, together with the most modern techniques. Despite its southern location, delicate freshness, good structure and fine complexity. The nose opens with delicate aromas of citrus and orange blossom, enriched with notes of linden and almond paste.

Graminé Vigneti delle Dolomiti 2021 (Longariva)

-The Graminé reveals itself in the glass in bright golden yellow. The bouquet of this white wine from Trentino-Alto Adige convinces with aromas of acacia. This wine presents a elegant dry flavour, balanced and complex. It was brought to the bottle with exceptionally little residual sugar

Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico "Barbangelo" 2022 (Benforte) Biological

-Jesi is located close to the Adriatic Sea, which provides the necessary cooling in the vineyard. You can taste this in the fresh character of the wine. Together with the floral notes and yellow fruit, the wine forms a complex whole.

Friuli

Friulano Colli Orientali 2022 (Marco Sara) Natural, Organic

54

-The Friulano from the Marco Sara winery is an organic white wine with floral, fresh tones and a straw yellow colour. On the nose there are pleasant aromas of yellow pulp fruit and honeyed and mineral hints. The sip is fresh, juicy, clean and with elegant mineral notes.

Pinot Grigio Ramato 2020 (Ronco Severo) Natural, Biodynamic

85

-This Pinot Grigio presents a brilliant copper color, with intense aromas of white pulp fruit, such as peach and pear, and dried fruit, such as walnut and almond, floral notes of honeysuckle, flowers of acacia and hay, spicy hints of pepper and cloves. The grapes are harvested by hand and then led to fermentation with their own skins and natural yeasts. This wine is then aged for 24 months in oak barrels.

Gavi di Gavi 2022 (La Caplana)

45

-Gavi is known for its straw yellow color as well as fine intensity and good consistency. Its aroma is intense with the scent of white flower and an aromatic trace of minerals. The taste is pleasantly fresh, savory and balanced with a fine structure and almonds aftertaste.

Roero Arneis 2022 (Tibaldi) Biological

45

-Tibaldi's Roero Arneis is a fresh and citrusy white wine, produced in the hamlet of Pocapaglia, in Piedmont by two sisters. On the nose it expresses delicate hints of white pulp fruit, wild flowers and citrus peel, notes that also return on the palate, accompanied by pleasant mineral nuances.

Pinner 2022 (Cavalotto) Biological

-This wine has a bright golden yellow color. The nose expresses intense aromas of tropical fruits (mango, papaya, passion fruit), with a strong reminder floral. In the mouth, it opens with great balance and structure, enveloping the palate with notes of exotic fruits on a nice acidity and mineral. Persistent, harmonious and fine.

Falanghina "Le Mattine" 2020 (Fonzone) Biodynamic

-This wine is produced from a grape with a high potential which has been undermined for a long time. The Falanghina by Fonzone is produced following the bio-dynamic principle and with a minimal intervention, partly fermented in amphora. The bouquet has scents of yellow apple, with peach and gorse. Highly mineral wine.

Vigna Carracci Falerno del Massico 2017 (Villa Matilde)

72

-This winemaker from Campania has been nominated in the top 100 of the world. One of his best white wines is this Cru Carracci, made from 100% Falanghina grapes. This wine matures for 5 month in barriques and 8 month in the bottle. The color is intense yellow with a golden reflection. The scent is also intense with rose, banana, pineapple, vanilla and almonds. The taste is full, velvety, elegant and persistent

-Grapes: Falanghina

Apianum Fiano di Avellino 2020 (Aroma)

72

-This Fiano riserva has a straw yellow color, nuances from citrus, lime and white flowers.

The harvesting is done by hand The fermentation starts in French and Hungarian barrique for at least 12 month, followed then from at least 6 month in bottle. The taste is deep and persistent, with ripe fruits: apricot, peach. The bouquet is rich nuts: hazelnut, almond and an hint of vanilla.

Tenuta dei preti Biancolella 2022 (Tommasone)

75

-This wine is the made in the island of Ischia, by the napoli coast. The bouquet is intense, broad and fruity with notes that recall the sweetness of pear pulp and ripe apricot, combined with a background of almond flowers and delicate floral sensations perfectly integrated with the current of balsamic aromas of the oak in which it matured. On the palate it is dense and enveloping, persistent and balanced, particularly harmonious and full-bodied in its minerality.

Mosaico per Procida 2020

-This wine is a wine made for the event "Procida Capitale Italiana della cultura" event done to celebrate the small island of Procida, Close-by the coast of Napoli.

This wine made by 26 different winery, in all the five provinces of Napoli. The grapes which are used are exclusively local grapes: Falanghina, Fiano, Greco, Coda di volpe, Asprino and Biancolella. Small production, only 6000 bottles were made.

The color is golden yellow. The bouquet is rich and persistent, yellow pulp fruits, citrus and honey. Dry and rich in the sapidity. nuances of medlar, apples and peaches.

-Grapes: Falanghina, Fiano, Greco, Coda di volpe, Asprino, Biancolella.

Sicilia

Grillo Lidie 2022(Avide)

45

-Bright straw yellow, the nose is fresh and fruity with notes of white peach and grapefruit combined with hints of aromatic herbs, in the mouth it is large, dry, clean, characterized by a flavor that is perfectly integrated into the tasting. excellent persistence.

Ciuri 2021 (Terrazze dell'Etna)Biological

-Light straw yellow with green reflections. Fresh and vibrant in the nose, with hints of tropical fruit and a reminder of rosemary. Sapid in the mouth, slightly accentuated body. Pleasant mineral finish. A wine of great pleasure, fruity and fragrant

Muller Thurgau 2021 (Fazio)

54

-Intense, persistent perfume, with delicate floral notes recalling the pleasant smell of spring's little roses; Taste intense, velvety, persistent flavour, on the palate delicate notes of spices.

Etna Bianco "Outis" 2022 (Ciro Biondi)

70

-Ciro Biondi's Etna bianco 'Outis' is made from carricante and cataratto from ancient volcanic soils. Floral with salty mineral notes, fine taste. The combination of bright acidity and minerality from the Carricante with the complex aromatic notes from the other varieties come together harmoniously in the glass. Bright pale straw colour in the glass, with aromas of wet stones, with hints of flowers, peach, apricot and herbs. A very flavourful palate impression with lively balancing acidity.

Verona bianco "Timido" 2021 (Corte Bravi) Natural

-Uva è nient'altro, the grape and nothing else is the motto of Corte Bravi. When you have the wine in your glass, you understand why. The classic grape varieties of the region have little pigment and Andrea Brunelli has respected that in the cellar. Natural yeasts, unfiltered, without added sulphites. Timido is white made from red grapes, fresh and pure.

Liguria

Harmoge 2016(Prima Terra)Biodynamic,Natural

-Traditional grape varieties of the Cinque Terre from terrace vineyards rich in shells and sand, give the name to this unique wine. Harmoge (from latin "Armony") stands perfectly to describe the balance between the different grapes that this wine is made of, and the spontaneous fermentation and maceration on the skins. A wine that is expressed on the nose with hints of candied fruit, notes of aromatic herbs, hints of resin and flint and sapid tones. On the palate the perfume is rich, soft, with great envelopment and minerality
